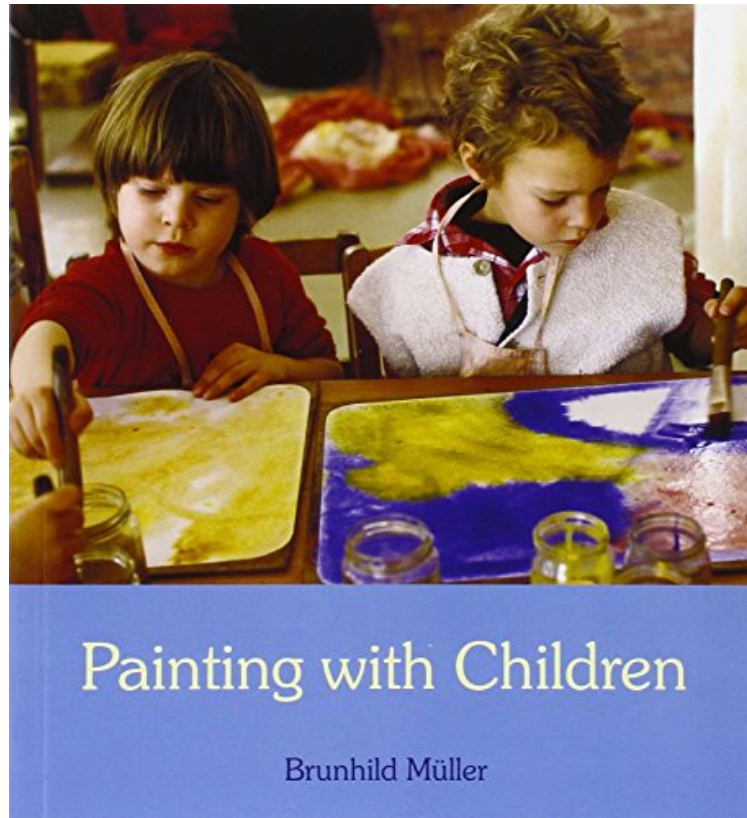

I bought this book as it is recommended by just about everyone in Waldorf. I was surprised by how incredibly short it is! The how-to section is NOT more detailed than what you can access for free online on various Waldorf sites. I was able to correct some problems with my technique by trial and error and by asking questions on various Yahoo groups, instead. In my opinion this book's main contributions are showing color paintings created by children at various ages and including a very short collection of some nice seasonal poems that can inspire one's painting. Really, not as helpful as I had hoped!

A vital factor in every child's development is the stimulation of active imagination and creativity. This book presents ideas that encourage self-expression through the medium of watercolors. Fundamental and practical, this book is based on Goethe's color theory, showing that painting with children is more than merely a form of self-expression.
