Tea bag folding is not just for scrapbooking, you can use these sheets, blocks, and patterns for greeting cards, labels, bookmarks, tags, and other paper craft items. Once you have used the papers (perforated for easy tear-out) save the patterns and sample concept photos to use with new papers. There are 18 sheets altogether, suitable for many occasions or celebrations, some are cutesy (teddy bears), but several are dramatic (faux marble or texture) and others are just plain pretty. Worth the investment, but since this book is not cheap (I think OOP, published in 2000), I suggest you cut and practice with other cheaper papers and same-size squares before you actually use the materials here in a finished product.

Tea bag scrapbooking is a variation of origami, the Japanese art of paper folding. Tea bag folding originated in Holland, using the pretty papers that tea bags were wrapped in. Tea bag scrapbooking brings all the backgrounds and the squares to complete 12 different album pages. Each finished page shows you how we use the clever stars, butterflies, and bordersthat our Dutch designer created.
